

Political Science terminology:

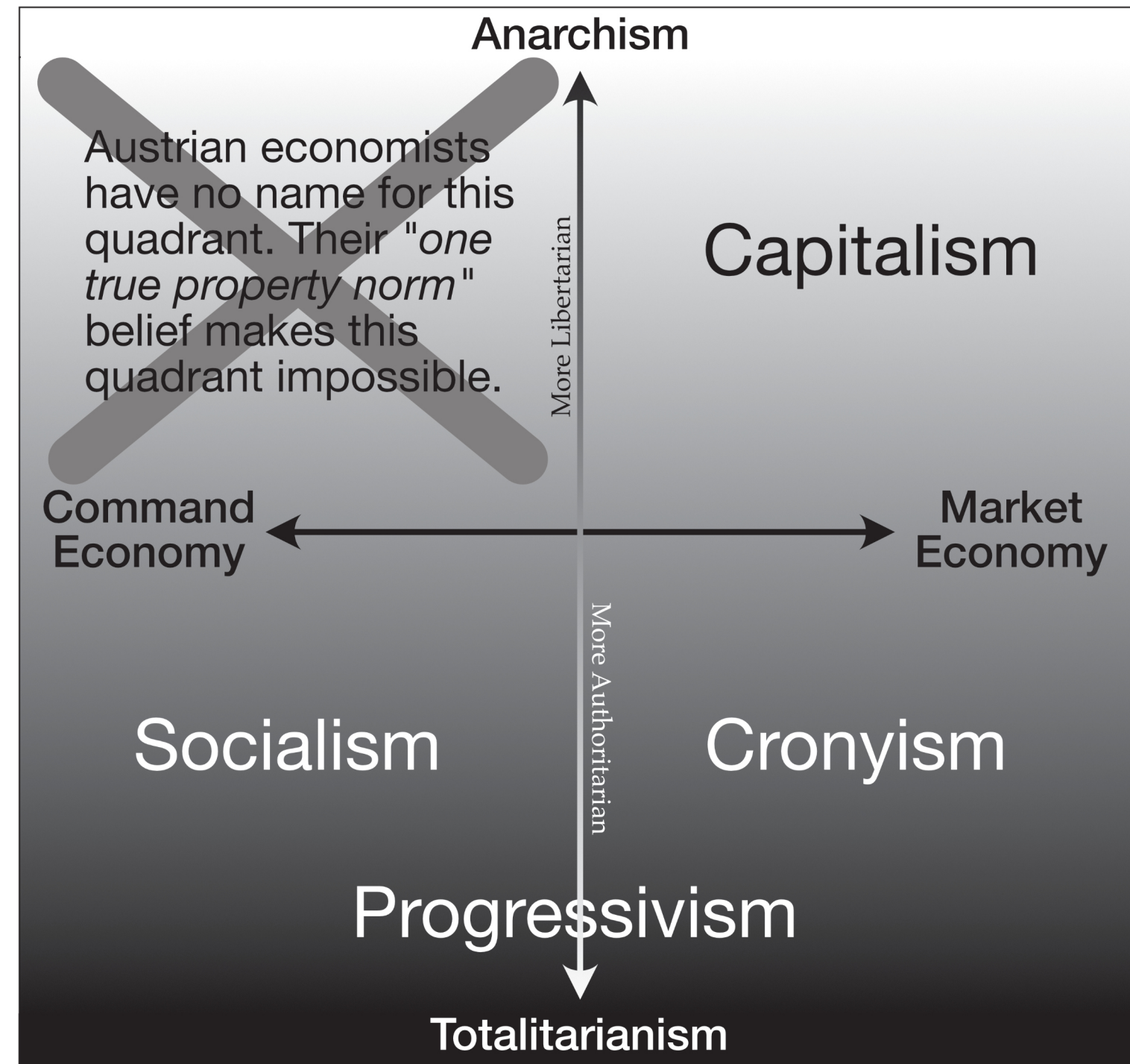
Y-axis

libertarian - little or no government power *aka* political authority
 statist - a large amount of government aggression power

X-axis

socialism - opposes private property; prefers collective norms
 capitalism - favors sticky private property, at least as a legal fiction

Anarchists (generally) assert that various norm sets satisfy natural law, e.g. voluntary forms of mutualism, geism, and socialism.



Austrian Economist terminology:

Y-axis

libertarian - little or no government power *aka* political authority
 statist - a large amount of government aggression power

X-axis

command economy - externally planned by political overseers
 market economy - emergent order of free markets & voluntary trade

Austrians (traditionally) deny that there can be more than one property norm satisfying natural law, e.g. with weaker abandonment norms.
